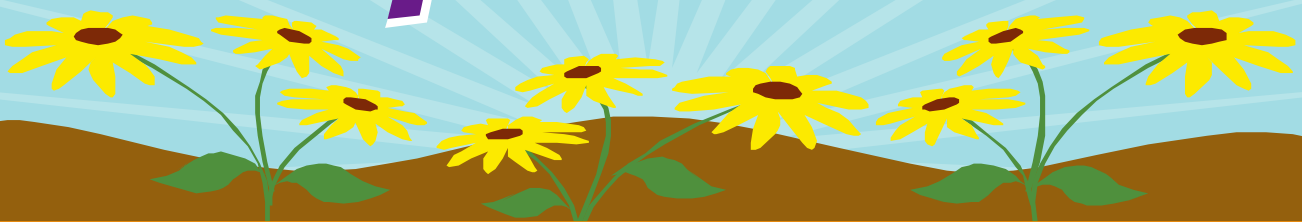

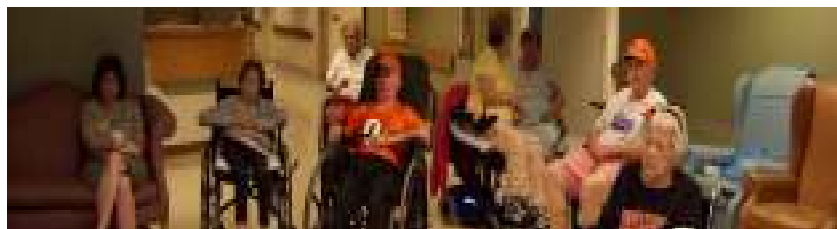
AROUND CINCINNATI...
